# Ring Size Finder

HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

## Step One

CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE

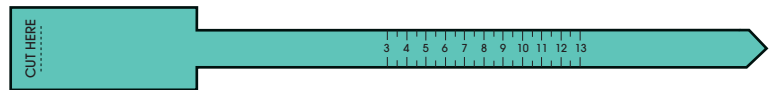
Measure the bar on the right, make sure it is 3 inches long. If not, check the settings in your print box. Ensure that you are printing the document at 100%.



TIPS: Measure your finger in warmer temperatures or at the end of the day. Also if you have a knuckle that is significantly larger than the base of your finger, use option 2. However you will need to measure both the knuckle and base of your finger. Select a size in the middle of the two numbers you get.

## Step Two

PICK AN OPTION



ONE - MEASURE FINGER WITH PAPER SIZER

- Carefully cut along the outline of the sizer. Cut a small slit in the left end of the sizer.
- Wrap the sizer around the finger intended for the ring with the numbers facing out.
- Slide the pointed end of the sizer through the slit.
- Move the sizer to the largest part of the finger, this may be the knuckle.
- Pull tightly. The sizer must fit snugly to produce an accurate size.
- The number that lines up at the split represents the ring size for that finger.

TWO - MEASURE CURRENT RING

- Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger. The "ring finger" is located between the little finger and middle finger.
- Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size.
- This measurement refers to the diameter of the ring. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
